

Operation Christmas Child – We all know that we collect shoebox gifts filled with fun toys, school supplies and hygiene items for children all around the world. Just imagine the joy as they open their boxes as this is the first gift that many children have ever received!

Did you know that every shoebox delivered to a child is an opportunity to share Jesus? Since 2009, 35.4 million shoebox recipients have participated in The Greatest Journey, a 12-lesson discipleship course created by Samaritan's Purse. Over 17.5 million boys and girls have made decisions for Christ!!

Last year, Hollies Baptist Church filled 62 boxes! This year our goal is 75. (Pastor Steve thinks we can do 100.) Our theme this year is "Operation Christmas Child-All Year Long". Please pray for God's guidance for your participation and for the children receiving a shoebox.

We are asking for your help as there are expenses associated with this ministry. Right now we need to order 100 Shoe Boxes and other items from Samaritan's Purse. The cost is \$72.00. Also, there will be a \$10.00 per box shipping and handling fee. Our youth will assemble several boxes. We currently have almost \$25.00 to cover these fees, but that is just a start. Any donations you can make between now and November are greatly appreciated.

Envelopes specifically for Operation Christmas Child donations are provided in the pews. Please make checks payable to Hollies Baptist and indicate that it is for Operation Christmas Child. Cash donations are also appreciated. Also, remember the "Change for Children" box in the sanctuary is for your loose change.

We suggest that you might want to start preparing your individual boxes now to avoid the rush in November. Here's an idea...get certain items monthly instead of having to purchase everything at once. For example, one month get hygiene items-toothbrushes, combs, brushes, washcloths, etc. Another month, purchase school supplies. Another month, a sport item or toy, etc. Also, please consider getting some extra items to help fill additional church boxes.
