The World Around Us – Romans

I know most of us get tired of the News around us, and the political issues that seem to give us the chills. I wake up every morning wondering what the newest and latest issues are and how to respond. Sometimes I wish there was no internet and face book to entertain our minds that are so captivated by the latest fashion and gossip about even someone you know! I have spent several weeks and probably a few more looking at the Book of Romans. Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Do you believe it?

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and to the Greek. ¹⁷ For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith. Romans 1:16-17

A beautiful text to encourage all believers, ending with "The just shall live by faith". Learning the process and understanding God's word is foremost in our life. This past Sunday we looked at Romans 5, it is a passage sharing God's promises for those who believe.

- c. Reign of Mankind (20,21) By Christ alone we have been given the opportunity to reign with Christ.

We will continue this series as Easter approaches and spending time looking at Rescue, the Death, and Resurrection of Jesus. Second, we will look at the Reign of mankind with Christ for all eternity.

I hope these thoughts are helpful as we follow Christ in these days of unknowns, remember the command to GO INTO ALL THE WORLD and preach the Gospel. As a Church in the world today, we have the Good News Christ is coming soon.
